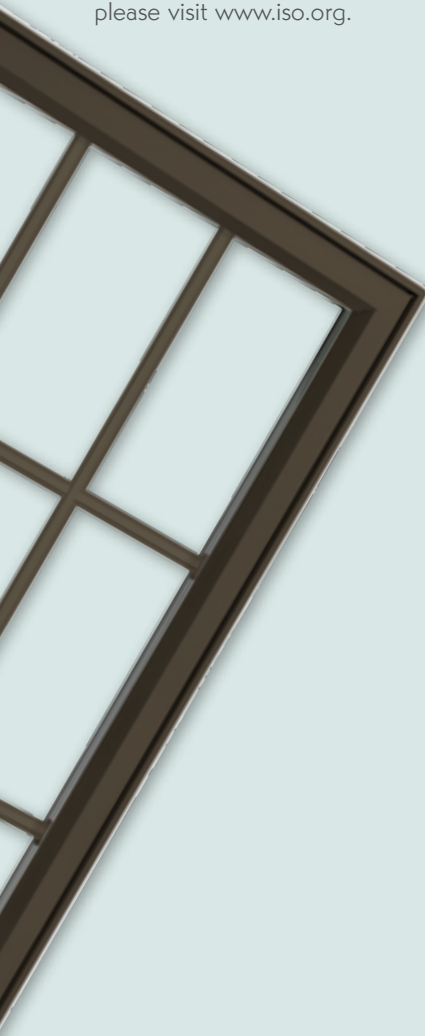

WHY IS EARNING THE NEW CERTIFICATION TO ISO 9001:2015 STANDARDS SIGNIFICANT?

ISO 9001:2015, which is the latest, more stringent version of ISO 9001, integrates with our quality systems already in place but also requires increased importance on leadership action, supply chain performance and risk prevention. Each area of achievement makes us stronger and better — it further separates Preservation from the competition.
